The theme for **CESI 2009** is: *Ethics from Boardroom to Bedside*.

CESI showcases expert faculty and innovations in clinical ethics from across Canada. Through lectures, panel discussions, case studies, small and large group discussions, and personal interaction between participants and faculty members, the Institute will provide participants with practical guidance and strategies for addressing ethical issues faced in healthcare.
